## Additional Topics

- **Poker Chip Raffle**
  - John Echel suggested a poker chip raffle as a new fundraising project.
  - A safe is purchased, and items of value will be placed in the safe.
  - The total value of the items in the safe will be \$5,000.
  - The contents will be unknown to participants.
  - 200 poker chips with values of \$1 to \$200 will be placed in a container.
  - Participants will draw a chip from the container and pay the amount listed on the chip to purchase a chance to win the safe and its contents.
  - If all chips are sold, the potential total from the raffle sales will be \$20,100, netting \$16,100 after purchase of the safe and items inside.
  - The chips will be offered for sale at all CCPF events, including the golf tournament and trivia night.
  - Richard will inquire if CCPF can have a table at Concerts in the Park to offer the chips.
  - Motion made by Rob; seconded by Seth to approve the project. No dissenting votes.


## Meeting Adjournment
